





Dr. Chandra Shaardha, HoD, BBA welcomed the guest and thanked him for accepting the invitation and sparing time from his busy schedule.






Col. Venkat began the session with a positive note, he talked about the first phase of implementation of the **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020** which involves various reforms in school curriculum to allow vocational skill training, preparation of holistic report card and local language as medium of instruction will be part of the initial reforms. He added NEP-2020, which will replace the National Policy on Education-1986, is an inclusive framework focusing on the elementary-level of education to higher education in the country.





He further discussed the other phases also and expressed that it is the need of the hour, he mentioned why students try to approach foreign universities for higher education, simply due to certain additional advantages that they get there, this new policy will bring in features


where students will be able to get all the facilities and a better teaching- learning environment in their home country itself.





He also discussed that the objective of any education system is to benefit children so that no child loses any opportunity to learn and excel because of circumstances of birth or background, NEP-20202 has a target of 100% Gross Enrolment Ratio (GEER), in school education by 2030.

The Policy reaffirms that bridging social gaps in access, participation, and learning outcomes in school education will continue to be one of the major goals of all education sector development programmes.
