### REPORT

#### **Objectives of the event:**

A Workshop in association with CARA was organized by the JIMS School of Law keeping in mind the IP University syllabus wherein the IInd year students are essentially required to visit CARA as part of their Professional Skill Development Activity. The Workshop by CARA was organized in the college itself to sensitize the students about the adoption process in India and the laws involved therein. Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA) is a statutory body of Ministry of Women & Child Development, Government of India. It functions as the nodal body for adoption of Indian children and is mandated to monitor and regulate in-country and inter-country adoptions. The workshop was attended by 2 esteemed experts from CARA namely; Dr. Archana Tyagi and Mr. Shishir Singh.

#### **Outcome of the event:**

1. The students learned through the experts from CARA about the practicalities of the adoption process in India and also about the inter-country adoptions.
2. Through this Workshop the students were sensitized to the fundamental as well as contemporary issues of substantive and procedural law relating to adoption in India.
3. The students got familiar with the fundamental provisions of Adoption Regulation 2017 and the Juvenile Justice Act 2015.
4. The students were sensitized to the regulatory and reformatory measures taken by the CARA in the adoption processes.
