REPORT

Objectives of the event: As per the IP University curriculum the IInd year students are essentially required to visit family courts as part of their Professional Skill Development Activity. As a part of this activity the students visited Patiala House, Tis Hazari Court, Karkardooma and Saket Court. The purpose of these visits is to apprise the students with practical aspects of the family law. The students get to experience what they learnt in the classrooms with respect to marriage, divorce, adoption, maintenance etc. being applied in the real case scenarios.
