Objectives of the event:

- To aware the people about Hepatitis disease
- To fulfil the PSDA under the curriculum of Health care Law
- Aware about Right to health

A “Health Awareness Program” was organized on August 9, 2019 at Safipur village, Greater Noida. The programme was commenced by the health care law students of BA.LLB 9th semester. The objective of the visit was to aware people about the disease called ‘Hepatitis’. Students in group of four were divided for spreading awareness regarding the same. They were asked to use Hindi language so that people can easily understand and should be aware of it. Firstly students start describing about the basic of Hepatitis that there are 5 types of hepatitis i.e. A,BC,D,E. They met many people including men, women and children when they were telling about hepatitis and its type they listened to it interestingly moreover they were curious to know more about this. Some of them even asked how they can prevent hepatitis and what treatments are available for people who are suffering from hepatitis. Students told them about ways to increase awareness of hepatitis through identification of symptoms of viral hepatitis include jaundice, dark urine, loss of appetite, abdominal pain, joint pain, fever, vomiting and diarrhea. They asked people to encourage vaccination, there is Hepatitis A vaccine for children 1 year of age and Hepatitis B vaccine for infants at birth. The Hepatitis B vaccine series should be completed by 6 to 18 months of age. And to provide educational resources by no. of ways through posters, pamphlets, talking to more and more people about the same. There is one more by getting involved by organizing events and campaigns dedicated to raising hepatitis awareness. And students told them to drink fresh and clean water and to avoid unhealthy food as well as consumption of alcohol. As hepatitis mainly affects the liver all suggested them to take Himalaya Liv.52 tablet once in a day for keeping their liver healthy. People of that village were so happy and in last we clicked

pictures with them. All over it is was wonderful experience for all the students of Health Care Law as the objective of the visit was accomplished.
