Objectives of the event:

The objective of the visit was to aware people about the “Health Care Policies run by Central and UP Government”.

A “Health Awareness Program” was organized by the health care law students of BA.LLB 9th semester. Students in group of four were divided for spreading awareness regarding the same. They were asked to use Hindi language so that people can easily understand and should be aware of it. Firstly students start describing about the basic of health care that there are various types of policies, programmes as well as schemes, are launched by the government specially for economic weaker sections, for providing benefits to them. They met with many people including men, women and children when they were telling about the policies they listened to it interestingly moreover they were curious to know more about this. Students told them about the various types of policies like,

- Ayushman Bharat Yojana
- Rastriya Bal Swasthya Karyakaram
- Shishu Suraksha Karyakaram
- Revised National TB Control Programme
- Mission Indradhanush
- National Tobacco Control Programme
- Pulse Polio
- AamAdmiBimaYojna
- Janani Suraksha Yojna

These are some schemes, launched by the government for the welfare of the people. Public healthcare is free and subsidized for below the poverty line people. Some of the people took imitative and asked about the benefits, students told them about benefits of such insurance plans like:-

- Cashless Treatment
- Cover for pre and post hospitalization fee
- Reimbursement for ambulance fees
- Expenses of routine medical check-ups
- In-patient hospital expenses
- Charges for treatment availed at home

People of that village were so happy about getting knowledge of various government health policy and their benefits. This was wonderful experience for all the students of Health Care Law as the objective of the visit was accomplished.
