## **Event Report**

A political survey to understand the sanitation facilities, awareness about the government & governances, local administrative bodies, etc was successfully conducted on 3rd February 2020 at village **Dabra**. The survey mainly focused on two broad aspects: Government Policies and Quality of Sanitation in the village. A team of 67 students was assigned the job to conduct the survey efficiently on large scale.



The following are the prime issues and problems were identified by the students about the villagers residing in the village as per the survey conducted:





- 1. There is no Government hospital or any dispensary in the village. Villagers have to travel a long distance to get medical aid.
- 2. There is no proper system of garbage disposal in the village. The garbage is dumped in a plot nearby.
- 3. There is no proper drainage/sewage disposal system in the village.
- 4. Government schools are not maintained up to date and lacks and proper functioning.
- 5. Lack of supply of Rashan even after availability of Rashan cards.
- 6. Employment opportunities are very low.
- 7. No free sanitary pads are provided to women of the village and thus they are forced to use cloth which have caused infection cases in many women of village.
- 8. Government schemes like 'pension for senior citizens' 'Clean India Drive' and etc. are not implemented and villagers too are not aware about anything.
- 9. No government official has ever arrived to check upon the condition of village.



The survey was conducted successfully with the guidance of our teachers and co-operation of people from village Dabra. It was an overall learning experience for the students. The survey was conducted under the supervision of Dr Deepti Sinha, Ms Shilpi Jha, Dr M.N. Rahman and Dr Richa Srivastava
