Department of Journalism & Mass Communication organised a Workshop cum interactive session on the topic: 'Common Errors in Hindi Writing' on Tuesday, October 15th 2019. Dr. Bal Mukund Sinha, was the key resource person for the program. Dr Sinha is a free lance journalist and academician Former Editor, Nav Bharat Times, New Delhi. He got his Doctorate Degree from JNU, New Delhi in Hindi Journalism. He was also associated with Chauthi Dunia, Dharmyug and Dinman. He has also been associated with Times Centre for Media Studies in the capacity of Director. He has been awarded numerous fellowships including The Times Fellowship, CSE and Media foundation award.



In his lecture Dr Sinha discussed the common mistakes we do while writing Hindi news. He also gave remedial measures to overcome these errors while writing. Starting his session he discussed about the right use of certain words in journalistic writing and how the meaning of the entire piece of information changes with just a simple mistake. He discussed about the new additions and changes incorporated in Hindi language by Central Institute of Hindi in recent years.

During the session students also took the opportunity to interact with him and get their queries answered directly.
