Note: This report comprises of three parts. **Part I** deals with parameters relating to physical infrastructure of an institute. **Part II** evaluates several parameters that concern academics standards & infrastructure of an institute. **Part III** deals with the efforts made by the institute in complying with the terms and conditions of grant of NOC of the Government of NCT of Delhi, academic audit report and affiliation of GGSIPU during the previous year.

The GGSIPU shall provide the Inspecting Teams, the proposals as submitted by the Institute along with copies of letter/s indicating the terms and conditions of NOC and affiliation along with the report of the last academic audit which were to be complied with by the institute, if any, and other relevant documents like concerned guidelines of the Govt. of NCT of Delhi, norms of the concerned statutory bodies (if applicable), etc.

Depending upon the marks obtained by an existing institute in Parts II & III, it may be placed in one of the following categories:

Category 'A'	The institute may be granted <b>Category A</b> , if it obtains 75% marks or more in Part II as well as in Part III, separately, of the assessment report.
Category 'B'	If the institute does not fulfill the requirement of award of marks for category 'A' in any of the Part II or III but has 65% or more marks in Part II and III separately then the institute is eligible for award of category 'B'.
Category 'C'	The institute may be granted <b>Category 'C'</b> , if it is not eligible for category 'A' or 'B' but obtains between 50% or more marks in Part II and III separately then the institute is eligible for award of category 'C'.
Category 'D'	If the marks obtained are less than 50% in any one part or in both parts i.e. Part II and Part III of the inspection report then the institute will be awarded 'D' Category and will also be put in No Admission Category.

Note:-

1. If the concerned department of the State Government or the University is of the opinion that NOC/ Provisional affiliation is not justified, the issuance of such NOC/provisional affiliation may be revoked after following proper procedure.
2. The inspection team should evaluate facilities available on the date of inspection and should not take into account promises made by the Society / Trust Managing the College/Institution.
3. Wherever required additional pages may be attached in the report.
4. All pages of the JAC report must be signed by all members of the committee.

# GUIDELINES FOR THE JAC MEMBERS

## PART ONE

**For calculating the marks to be awarded for Faculty Cadre Ratio (FCR):-**

SF = Senior Faculty (Professors + Associate Professors)  
JF = Junior Faculty (Assistant Professors)  
TS = Teachers Students Ratio as defined by the AICTE / other bodies  
S = Number of students per division  
N = No. of Divisions approved  
D = Duration of the programme  
t = Reciprocal of Teachers Students Ratio =  $1/TS$   
K = Total Teaching Faculty Required as per the Norm =  $\frac{S \times N \times D}{t}$   
f = Cadre Ratio Factor (CRF) =  $\frac{(K - \text{SF actually in position})}{\text{SF actually in position}}$

If the required FCR is 1:2 and the worst FCR acceptable is 1:7, the marks will be awarded as per following formula :-

$$\text{Awarded Marks} = 50 + 10(7-f)$$

(Cap to 100)

However, when the term within the parenthesis (7-f) becomes negative, the marks awarded will be zero. Therefore, an institute having Actual FCR 1:8, then CRF (f) becomes 8, the Marks Awarded will be '0' (Zero).

For more explanation, please see the example on next page.



### Example

For any programme of 03 years duration with one division of 60 students, where Teachers Students Ratio is 1:20

1. Total teaching faculty required  $K = (S \times N \times D) / (t) = (60 \times 1 \times 3) / (20) = 9$
2. Here, in Ideal Case, the requirement of SF & JF, CRF and Awarded Marks will be calculated as under:-
  - a) Requirement of SF =  $1 \times (K/3) = 1 \times (9/3) = 1 \times 3 = 3$  (if the value is in decimal, the value shall be considered in next whole number)
  - b) Requirement of JF =  $2 \times (K/3) = 2 \times (9/3) = 2 \times 3 = 6$  (if the value is in decimal, the value shall be considered in whole number only and value in decimal shall be ignored)
  - c) CRF (f) =  $(K - \text{SF actually in position}) / (\text{SF actually in position}) = (9 - 3) / 3 = 6 / 3 = 2$  (the value shall be considered 2, in case it is less than 2)
  - d) Awarded Marks =  $50 + 10(7 - f) = 50 + 10(7 - 2) = 50 + 10 \times 5 = 50 + 50 = 100$
3. Suppose, in above case any institute having 1 SF, then
  - a) CRF (f) =  $(K - \text{SF actually in position}) / \text{SF actually in position} = (9 - 1) / 1 = 8 / 1 = 8$
  - b) Awarded Marks will be  $50 + 10(7 - f) = 50 + 10(7 - 8)$ . As parenthesis (7-f) is -1, hence, the marks awarded will be '0'.

## PART TWO

### FOR CALCULATING THE MARKS TO BE AWARDED FOR TEACHERS STUDENTS (TS) RATIO

#### Case One

*(For BBA, BCA, B.A.-Economics, B.A.-English, B.Sc-Yoga Science, B.Com, BJMC, B.Tech, BHMCT, MCA & MBA)*

Where the Required TS ratio is 1:20, the worst TS ratio acceptable will be 1:25

And the Awarded Marks will be as per the formula given below:

$$\text{Awarded Marks for TS ratio} = 50 + 10(25-t)$$

(Cap to 100)

Where the  $t$  = Reciprocal of Teachers Students Ratio.

For example, for an institute having Actual TS ratio 1:20,  $t=20$ ,  
and the Awarded marks  $= 50 + 10(25-20) = 50 + 50 = 100$

For an institute having Actual TS Ratio 1:21,  $t=21$ ,  
and the Awarded marks  $= 50 + 10(25-21) = 50 + 40 = 90$ , and so on

However, the moment the term within the parenthesis  $(25-t)$  becomes negative, the marks awarded will be zero, for example, for an institute having Actual TS ratio 1:26,  $t=26$ , the Marks Awarded WILL BE ZERO

#### Case Two

*(For B.Arch & B.Plan)*

Where the Required TS ratio is 1:16, the worst TS ratio acceptable will be 1:20

And the Awarded Marks will be as per the formula given below:

$$\text{Awarded Marks for TS ratio} = 50 + 12.50(20-t)$$

(Cap to 100)

Where  $t$  = Reciprocal of Teachers Students Ratio.

For example, for an institute having Actual TS ratio 1:16,  $t=16$ ,  
and the Awarded marks  $= 50 + 12.50(20-16) = 50 + 50 = 100$

For an institute having actual TS ratio 1:17, then  $t=17$ ,  
and the Awarded marks  $= 50 + 12.50(20-17) = 50 + 37.50 = 87.50$  and so on

But for an institute having Actual TS ratio beyond 1:20 i.e.  $t=21$ , the term within parenthesis  $(20-t)$  becomes negative and the Marks Awarded WILL BE ZERO, as explained earlier.



### Case Three

*(For B.Pharma, M.A.-Criminology, M.Sc-Forensic Science, MAHM & MCPHM)*

Where the Required TS ratio is 1:15, the worst TS ratio acceptable will be 1:20

And the Awarded Marks will be as per the formula given below:

$$\text{Awarded Marks for TS ratio} = 50 + 10(20-t)$$

(Cap to 100)

**But for an institute having Actual TS ratio beyond 1:20 i.e.  $t=21$ , the term within parenthesis (20-t) becomes negative and the Marks Awarded **WILL BE ZERO**, as explained earlier.**

### Case Four

*(For M.Tech & MHMCT)*

Where the Required TS ratio is 1:12, the worst TS ratio acceptable will be 1:15

And the Awarded Marks will be as per the formula given below:

$$\text{Awarded Marks for TS ratio} = 50 + 16.67(15-t)$$

(Cap to 100)

**But for an institute having Actual TS ratio beyond 1:15 i.e.  $t=16$ , the term within parenthesis (15-t) becomes negative and the Marks Awarded **WILL BE ZERO**, as explained earlier.**

### Case Five

*(For B.Sc.-Nursing & M.Sc.-Nursing)*

Where the Required TS ratio is 1:10, the worst TS ratio acceptable will be 1:12

And the Awarded Marks will be as per the formula given below:

$$\text{Awarded Marks for TS ratio} = 50 + 25(12-t)$$

(Cap to 100)

**But for an institute having Actual TS ratio beyond 1:12 i.e.  $t=13$ , the term within parenthesis (12-t) becomes negative and the Marks Awarded **WILL BE ZERO**, as explained earlier.**

### Case Six

*(Only for Law Programmes)*

**Where the Required TS ratio is 1:20, the worst TS ratio acceptable will be 1:40**

And the Awarded Marks will be as per the formula given below:

**Awarded Marks for TS ratio =  $50 + 2.5(40 - t)$**

(Cap to 100)

**But for an institute having Actual TS ratio beyond 1:40 i.e.  $t=41$ , the term within parenthesis (40-t) becomes negative and the Marks Awarded **WILL BE ZERO**, as explained earlier.**

**Calculations for Case 3, 4, 5 & 6 are self-explanatory on the pattern stated for Case One & Two**

**Any institute not obtaining at least 75% for 'A' Category and 65 % for 'B' Category in Part III shall be placed in the immediate succeeding category.**

### **VERY IMPORTANT NOTE:**

The above calculation has been done keeping in view the requirement of Teachers for the complete duration of the course. However, in cases where new programme has been started or to be started or for programmes where atleast one batch of students has not passed out, the requirement of teachers shall be calculated proportionately.
