A special food stall was set up, serving delicious Holi treats such as gujiya, thandai, and sweets. Students relished these traditional delights while enjoying the celebrations.

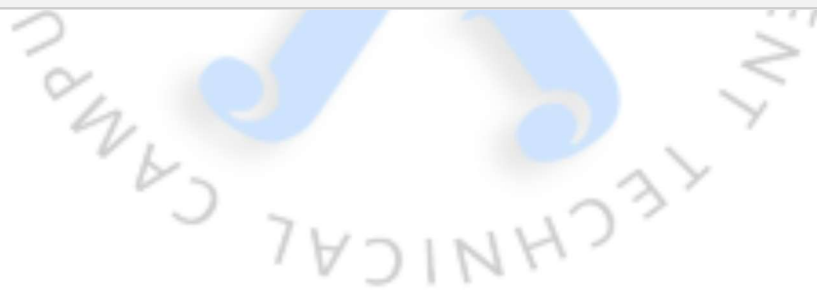
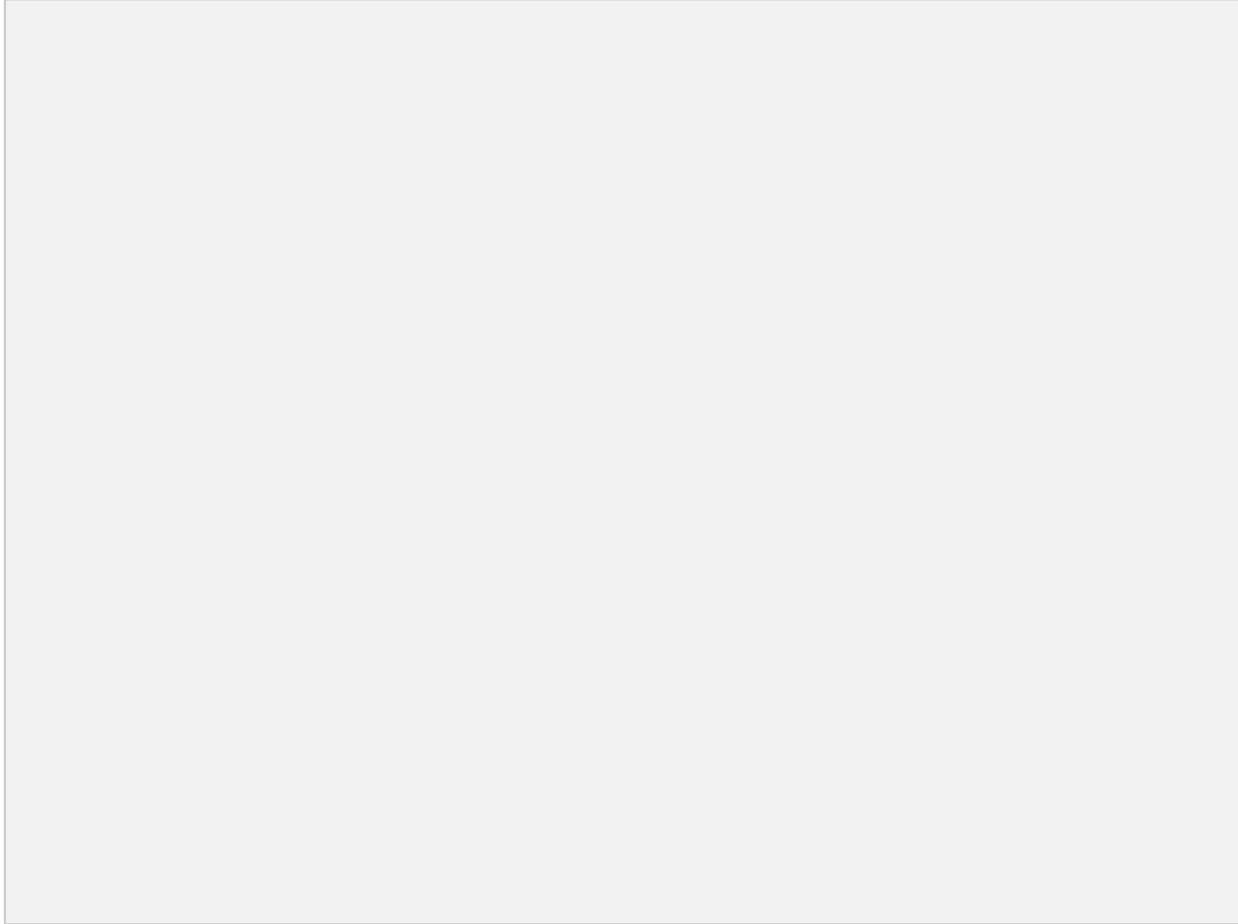
4. Fun Games and Activities
