The medical camp offered, benefiting residents with free health checks, screenings, and consultations. The camp, held on 8<sup>th</sup> February, 15<sup>th</sup> February and 1<sup>st</sup> March 2025, saw numerous individuals utilize the available services, including general health check-ups, blood sugar level and pressure tests. The NSS volunteers played a crucial role in ensuring the camp's success, providing guidance and support to all attendees.

Here's a more detailed breakdown:

**Objective and Activities:**

- Purpose: To provide free medical assistance and awareness to the local community.
- Services Offered: General health check-ups, blood sugar level testing, blood pressure testing, dermatology/skin check-ups, and free medicine distribution.
- Volunteer Involvement: NSS volunteers conducted surveys, home visits, awareness programs on health and hygiene, and assisted with all aspects of the camp.

**Impact and Outcomes:**

- Beneficiary Count:

A significant number of villagers participated in the camp, with 96 individuals attending the main event and benefiting from the services.

- Health Check-ups:
