Place of Activity: Village survey on topic “Social Audit of Reservation Policy of India.”

Date: 19th February, 2026

Report- On 19 February, 37 students from the Department of Law, JEMTEC, Greater Noida visited Khodna Khurd village as part of an academic outreach initiative to understand grassroots perspectives on reservation policies in India. Students interacted with villagers from different social backgrounds regarding the impact and awareness of reservation policies among SC, OBC, ST, and General categories. While many beneficiaries appreciated reservation for improving access to education and employment, others highlighted issues such as lack of awareness and unequal distribution of benefits. The visit helped students understand the complexities of social justice, policy implementation, and inclusive development beyond classroom learning.
