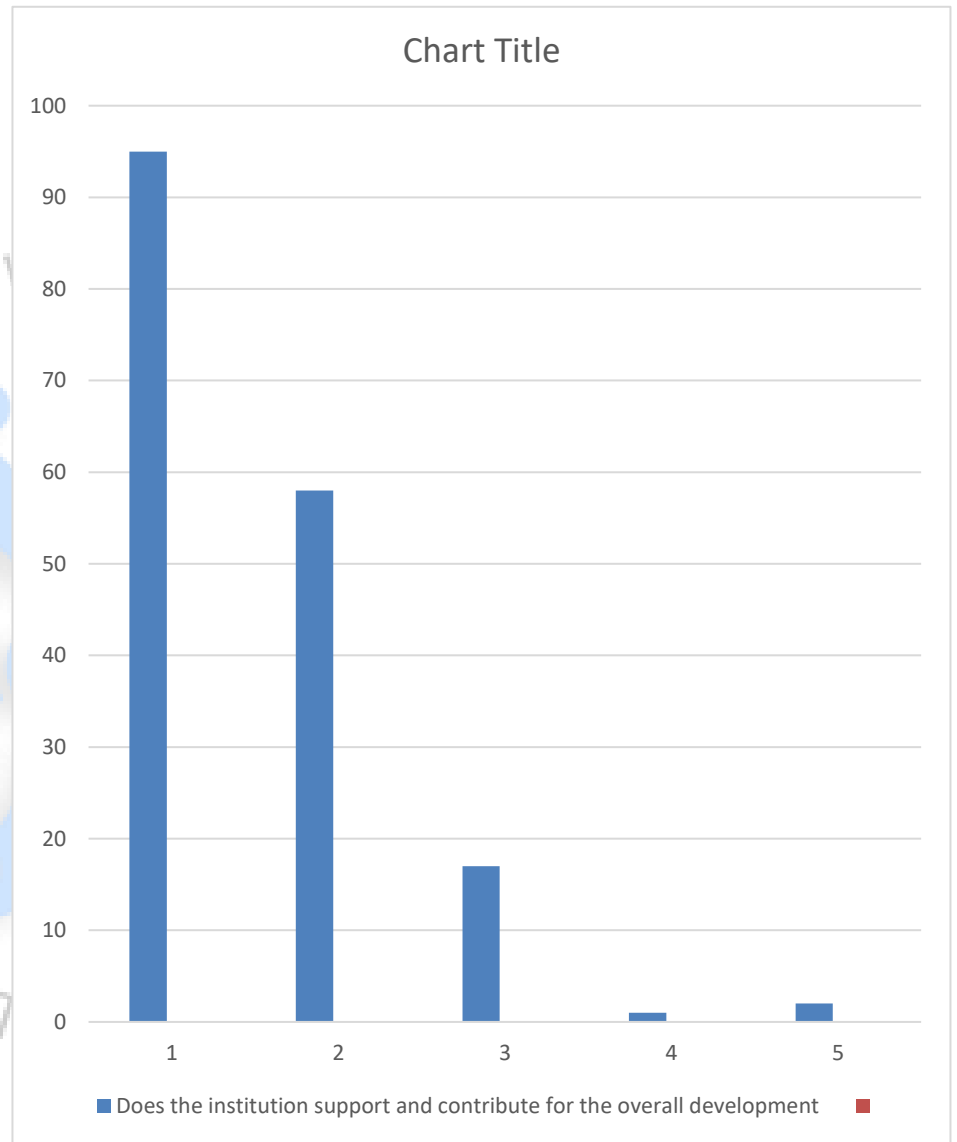
Analysis Report of Alumni' Feedback 2024 -25 on syllabus and its Transaction at the institution.

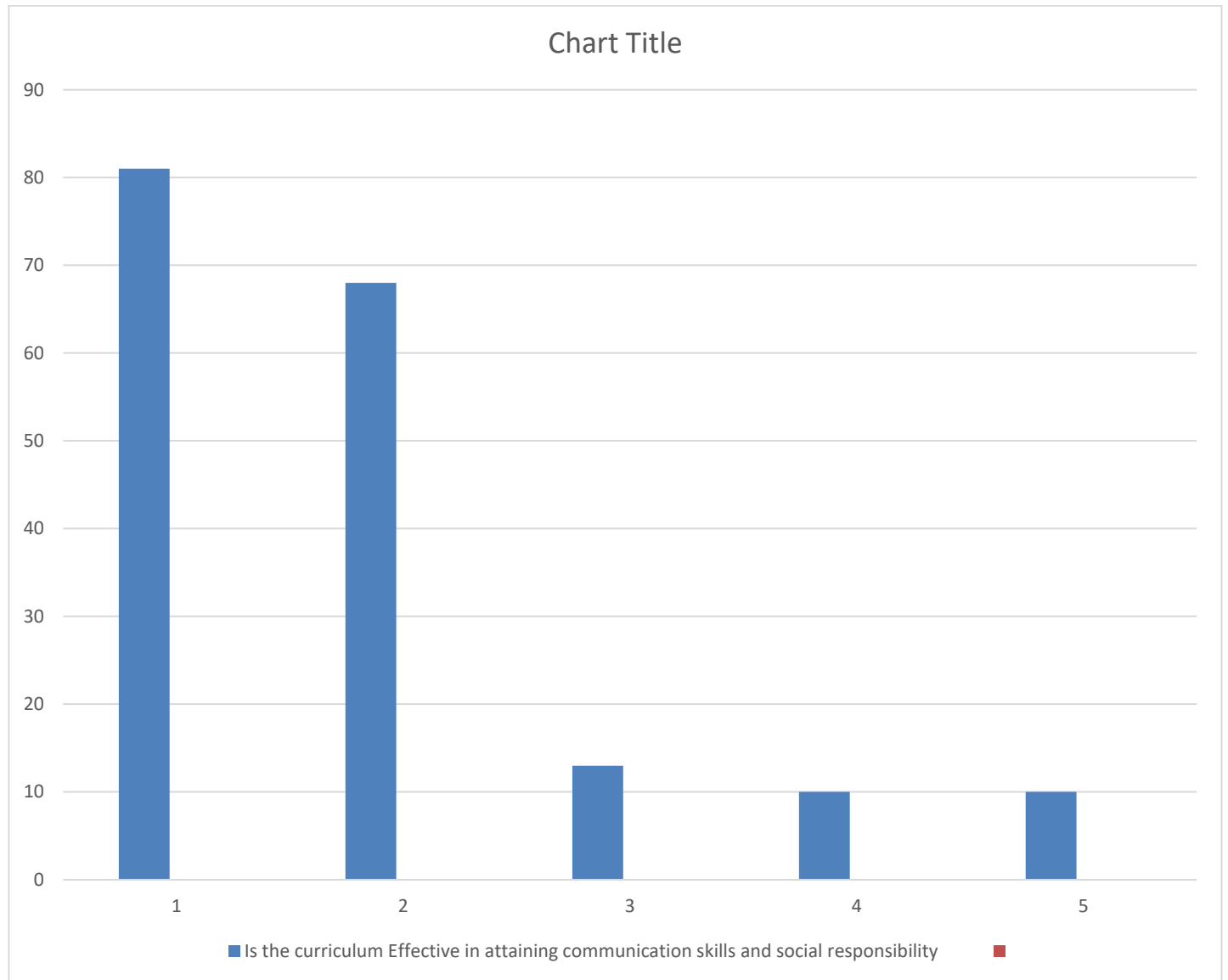

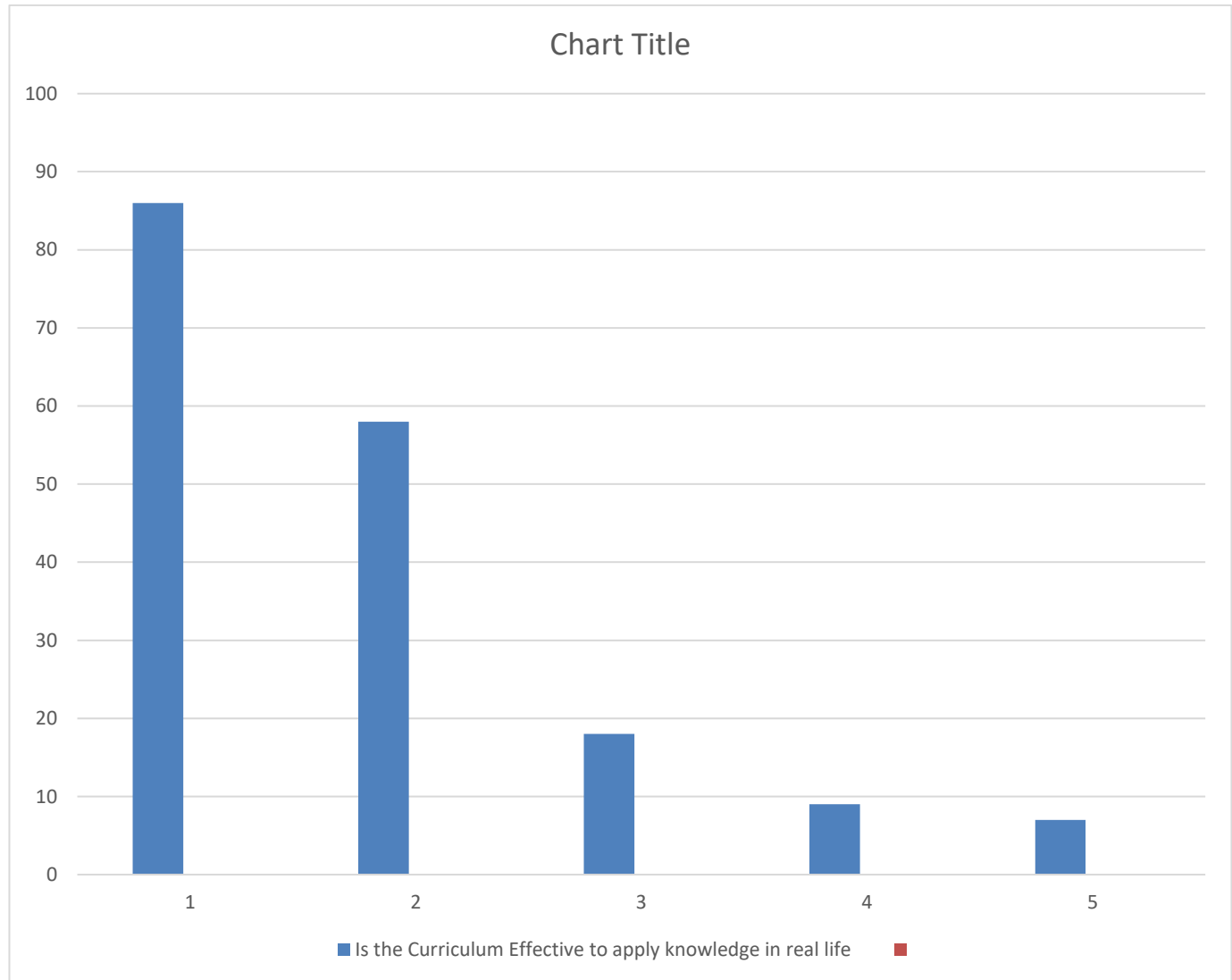

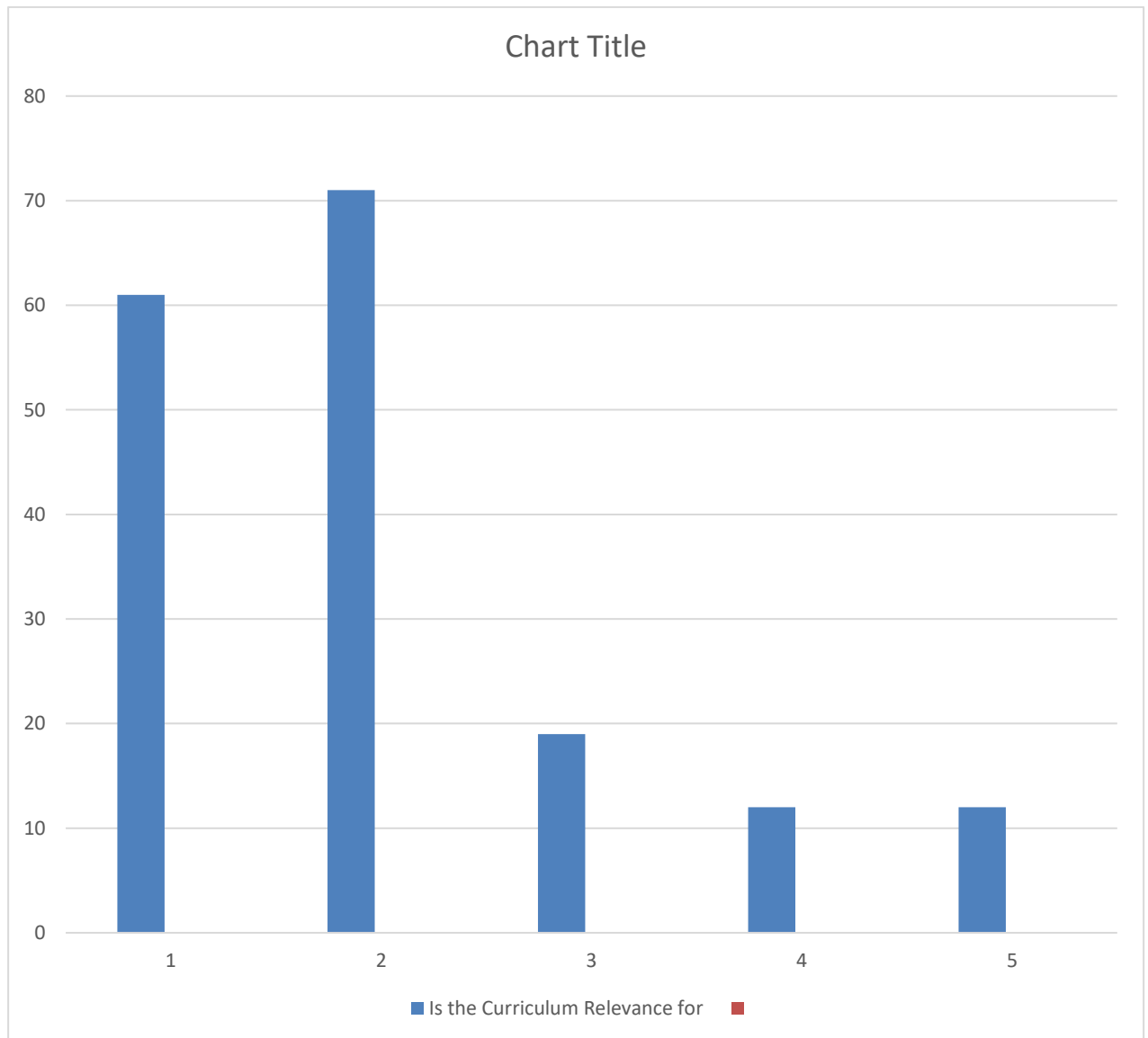
